<sup>a</sup> 2 warning triangles are compulsory with a trailer.

<sup>b</sup> 1 warning triangle is compulsory if the car has a Dutch registration number, 2 warning triangles are compulsory if the car has a Spanish registration number.

<sup>c</sup> 2 warning triangles are compulsory.

<sup>d</sup> Mandatory for driver only.

<sup>e</sup> Hazard triangle mandatory only if hazard lights are not functioning.

<sup>f</sup> Keep within easy reach.

<sup>g</sup> Does not apply to cars with xenon, neon or LED lights.

<sup>h</sup> In a campervan or car with caravan, must have an approved fire extinguisher containing at least 2 kg of extinguishing agent.

<sup>i</sup> It is compulsory to have a spare wheel in the car plus tools for changing a tyre.

If a spare wheel is not part of the standard equipment, a tyre repair kit or spray can with anti-puncture spray is also allowed.

<sup>j</sup> It is mandatory to have a spare wheel in the car together with tools to change a tyre.

If a spare wheel is not part of the standard equipment, a tyre repair kit or spray can with anti-puncture spray is also allowed.

<sup>k</sup> V-16 flashing light - Since 1 July 2021, instead of a warning triangle, it is allowed to carry a V-16 flashing light specially approved in Spain in the car. This orange flashing light must then be placed on the roof of the car from the door window in case of a breakdown or accident. From 1 January 2026, this special flashing light will become compulsory and placing a warning triangle will no longer be allowed.
